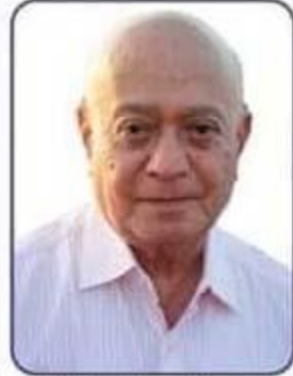

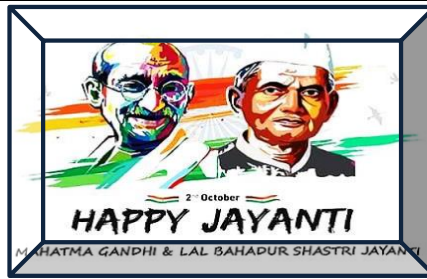

## Study Skills Training

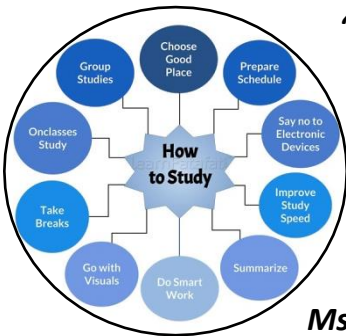

## Principal's Day



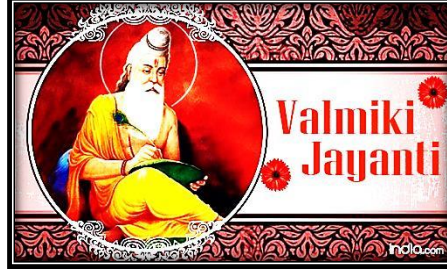

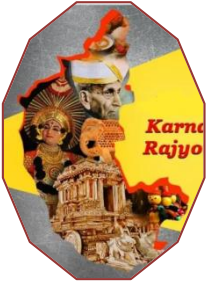
