Remedial Teaching Training

"Remedial teaching" is an instruction to provide assistance to students who, for whatever reason, have fallen behind the rest of the class in certain areas. Remedial education is assigned to assist students in order to achieve expected competencies in core academic skills such as literacy and numeracy.



Ms. Lola Shivshankar the SSF from ACT, Bengaluru conducted Remedial training session for teachers of Sri Ranganath International, Bagalkot on **25th November 2023**. Particularly the training ***focused on students with varying socio-economic backgrounds, ensuring that they receive the necessary sustenance and attention.***

Remedial teaching strategies implemented:

- 1. Re-teaching:** Reinforcement of key concepts to solidify understanding.
- 2. Task analysis:** Breaking down complex tasks to simplify learning.
- 3. Additional practice:** Providing extra exercises for focused skill development.
- 4. One-on-one teaching:** Personalized attention to cater to individual learning styles.
- 5. Error analysis:** Identifying and addressing errors before re-engaging with material.
- 6. Review in a new way:** Encouraging diverse approaches to reviewing and understanding.

The session also included ***understanding and addressing learning disabilities***. The teachers underwent training in reward schemes, including positive reinforcement and significantly contributed to an improved pass percentage, showcasing the

effectiveness of the remedial programme.

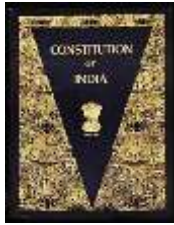

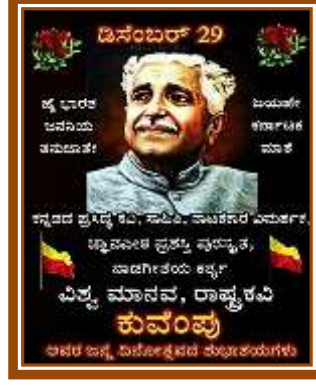
Students were actively engaged with customers, explaining product origins
