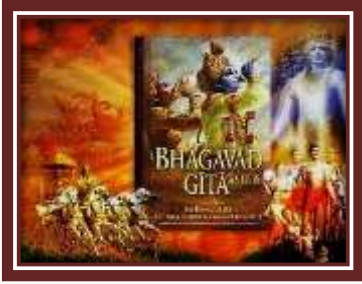

Bhagavad Gita Contest

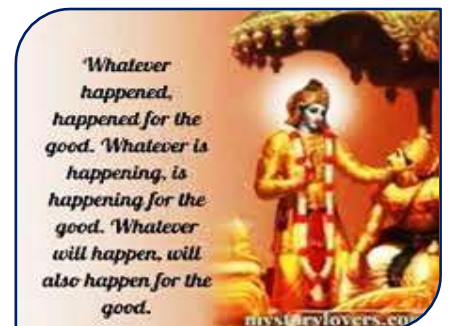
INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY FOR KRISHNA CONSCIOUSNESS

"If we are to preserve culture, we must continue to create it" – Johan Huizinga



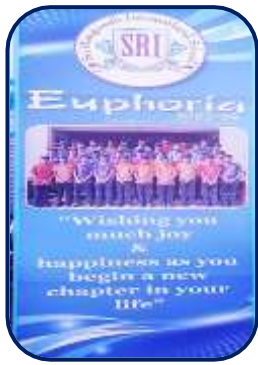
